Voting is done by a show of hands: positions with only one (1) nomination require 2/3 majority; positions with two (2) require only a majority; refer to policy for procedures for handling three (3) or more nominees for the same position.

IRAN fellowship printing their own literature (Iran RD letter sent out earlier- will forward NAWS response when I dig it up) A reminder to GSRs what the FIPT (Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust) is about and how it might relate
The CAR report will be coming up at the end of the year (November) - workshops will be set up; a few items of interest include:

* Motion K - a work group to examine if the current NAWS biz plan is "financially prudent" (pandemic, zoom, supply chain etc.)

Motion B - Project plan for "back to basics" style step study 'booklet' - questions related to basic text sentences

We (SFR) re-submitted the South Atlantic car motion, which was confirmed and has been identified as "Motion K", we (RD-AD) now have to work with Jack and Irene, our assigned world board contacts, to make this motion "CAR ready" but the wording below has been verified as of now with the board

Motion K

Motion to read: Before the end of the current lease of the WSO, the business plan workgroup will investigate if it is financially prudent to change the location of the office. They will then present a report sent out to the fellowship the following annual report explaining what factors shaped the decision to keep the same location or change it. Intent: This is not intended to micromanage the office or direct them to change locations. Simply to help the fellowship understand how these decisions are made in order to foster more trust. I've been told that this research is a standard part of business for the business plan workgroup, and we would just like the process and outcome made available to those in the fellowship that are interested.

We also submitted the motion from Area de Habla Hispana del sur de Florida, and I have received confirmation that we are now a comaker of that motion, see wording below in both English and Spanish.

MOTION B: To direct the World Board to develop a project plan, for consideration at WSC-2022, to create a booklet of Step study questions with the parameter that each question is derived from one sentence in the Basic Text chapter 'How It works'.

INTENT: To create a fellowship approved, inexpensive, NA Step study questions booklet that relates directly back to the Basic Text.

MAKERS: Baja-Son Region, Occidente, Northern California, Southern California, South Florida

RATIONAL by REGION: The need is for elemental non-personal NA Step study material that can be read one-on-one, in NA group meetings, in institutions and in Behind The Walls correspondence. When the answers to study questions are the sentences in NA literature then issues of personality, ego, politics, religion and other affiliations are removed. The answer is always the original line in the Basic Text from which the question was created. With a booklet of Basic Text Step study questions and the Introductory Guide, it is possible to teach and/or study the NA program for about \$3 USD. We believe we are identifying a need not generally understood in the first world English speaking part of our Fellowship. donations, we are requesting your support for the tools we need to succeed. The result of Instead of asking for this motion would be a stapled booklet about the size of the Group Booklet. The NA Introductory Guide combined with Basic Text Step Study Questions is an inexpensive way to bring the NA program into both the incarceration and addiction rehabilitation environments. A first time through the Steps with the Basic Text provides a strong foundation for all members and facilitates future study with other NA literature. The Basic Text is uncomplicated, heartfelt NA recovery literature which addicts can identify with and embrace. This piece would logically be translated after the NA Intro Guide and before the book length Basic Text, reducing the development time for emerging fellowships to be able to study the NA program.

We are now only 5 months away from the next Conference Agenda Report, and we have a good idea what a lot of it will be. Expect the proposals for the alterations of the FIPT and the bulletins associated with it, a motion to review gender specific and monotheistic terms in our lit, and several motions involving WSC cycle length and procedures, as well as seating related motions and who is considered a participant, and the level of participation they have.

Some projects have already begun, front end input for revision of "The Loner" IP, and a survey to frame the proposed IP on DRT/MAT are out currently.
