Voting is done by a show of hands: positions with only one (1) nomination require 2/3 majority; positions with two (2) require only a majority; refer to policy for procedures for handling three (3) or more nominees for the same position.*

Hello everyone from the Gold Coast Area Public Relations Subcommittee, I am an addict in recovery named Rocky. The PR Subcommittee met on 10/31 at 7:30 PM via Zoom online conference platform. We had seven (7) voting members in attendance with four (4) new members joining the subcommittee this month. We are always seeking new members, and all are always welcome to come sit in and be a part of our amazing group of trusted servants. You do not have to hold a position to join us and see how the public relations committee functions, all are welcome to log on. Dates and online links are always listed at the end of our monthly report as well as the Gold Coast Area website. Hope to see you all there.

What's new at PR?

- We are looking to have a workshop for PR learning day in 2023 and creating an informative video based on disaster response coordination, how its organized and how this is done.
- We're planning a PR poster day on 12/18/2022, we have created a new poster to distribute to the area to be voted on, the sample of the poster will be at the very bottom of this page.
- We met with the Fort Lauderdale Police department to schedule a presentation at their 2nd shift 12pm briefing. On 09/27/2022 we held a PR presentation that included 30+ patrol men and women as well as a few high ranking officers from the department. The presentation went extremely well and we handed out 50+ meeting lists and QR code cards for them to have in their squad cards. - The PR committee has brought up the idea of a position called Event/Outreach coordinator, their duties would include working with the PR committee to create a generic email format to send to outside organizations, communicate back and forth with these outside organizations, and schedule dates and times for presentations with the help of the PR chairperson and secretary. The intent is to create more opportunities for presentations and booths with organizations within our local community to better fulfill our primary purpose.
- We have been invited to a Thanksgiving community outreach event held by the Broward County Sheriff's office Deerfield Beach district. We have been told that we can set up a booth for this event. We will have 2 or more members from the PR committee to attend this event.
