This includes, but is not limited to, all negotiable contracts for hotel, merchandise, and entertainment contracts. C. After paying all expenses, seed monies should be paid to the next two succeeding conventions in this manner. 1. 80%, not to exceed \$5,000 to next year's convention. 2. 10%, not to exceed \$5,000 to the convention two years out.
